PRS-15°-Stop for ball heads



Installation and function of the 15° stop button (PRS button)

All FLM ball heads of the FT series can later be retrofitted with the 15° stop system. The protective cover on the ball head housing is removed with a suitable screwdriver or coin (fig. 1). In its place the 15° stop button is fixed by means of a 10mm spanner (fig. 2).

The latching function of the 15°-stop button is activated by turning the grey grip sleeve to the right and can be finely adjusted with its help. Deactivation is done by turning to the left. An audible and perceptible grid click during panorama rotation now enables single image recordings at the smallest distance of 15°.

By pressing the black 15° stop button at position "0" the panorama shelf locks into place (fig. 3). Now the tripod head is screwed on or removed from the tripod by simultaneously holding the pressed button. Especially at changing temperatures, this additional function enables fast and safe handling.
